



TWI Participates in 22nd Annual Clean Your Streams

The Toledo Waterways Initiative again participated in the Clean Your Streams event on Saturday, Sept. 22.

TWI was one of several organizations with educational and interactive tables at the Appreciation Picnic to reinforce the importance of clean waterways and ways volunteers can make a difference.

This year marked the 22nd Clean Your Streams event in the Toledo region and engaged nearly 1,000 volunteers in cleaning the area's waterways.

Hosted by Partners for Clean Streams, Clean Your Streams is an annual event that puts the clean waterways mission into action. For three hours on a Saturday every September, volunteers join forces to clean tons of trash from more than 30 miles of rivers in the greater Toledo area. Clean-up sites span dozens of high-profile stream banks along major waterways, tributaries and ditches. All trash collected is recorded, and that data supports local and international research with the International Coastal Cleanup.
