Community Program Advisory Committee Meeting Minutes
October 20, 2009

Kerry started the meeting at noon stating there have not been many changes since the last meeting. Items discussed were:

1. The LTCP has received conditional approval from the U.S. EPA.
2. We are currently waiting to receive the Pathogen Study dry-trial run test results. The samples have been sent to the lab. It may take up to three months to receive the results.
3. The chlorination season ends this month. Due to lack of rain we were unable to get any results. The system shuts down during the winter months and will be run again in the spring.
4. Steve Hallett, Administrator of the City of Toledo's Division of Water Reclamation gave a brief overview of the facilities day-to-day operation.
5. Chris Middlebrough, Commissioner of the City of Toledo's Division of Water Reclamation, explained the Wet Weather Treatment process.
6. Attendees were given a tour of the facility by Chris Middlebrough and Steve Hallett.

The meeting adjourned at 1:15 p.m.
